SHSAA SCHOLARSHIP ASSESSMENT PROCESS

Each applicant for a SHSAA scholarship will be reviewed and evaluated by select members of the SHSAA Board of Directors. The following 4-step process has been created to provide guidelines for each reviewer to use. Each applicant will be given an **overall** score based on the way each of the following assessment steps are scored by each reviewer. Each applicant must be reviewed by at least 3 members of the SHSAA Board of Directors.

STEP 1: Determine eligibility. Use the Eligibility Checklist to ensure that the applicant has met the minimum eligibility requirements. To be eligible, the applicant must answer YES to either

STEP 2: Assess the applicant's essay using the essay scorecard. This scorecard includes the essay sections described in the Scholarship manual. The essay is designed to evaluate the way the applicant thinks, communicates, and expresses ideas related to the essay topic. Each section will be assessed according to the point scale attributed to each section. Each section should be approximately 150 words. We look for creativity, insights, and content presented in a polished

STEP 3: Assess the online application form and reference letter(s). The applicant must submit a completed application form and at least one reference letter.

STEP 4: Return your assessment for each applicant to Carol Wolfenbarger. In addition, add any personal notes, comments, or observations that you feel are relevant.
